Dear Mr. Auerbach:

This is in response to correspondence that you submitted to PennDOT requesting approval to install an all-way stop at the intersection of Appleton and Strickersville Roads.

Due to the increased foot traffic and the sight distance concerns that are present, depending on where pedestrians are crossing Appleton Road, and also taking into consideration the increased farming activities in the area, the department <u>will approve</u> an all-way stop condition at the intersection of Appleton and Strickersville Roads.

The department will install STOP Signs on Appleton Road, along with STOP AHEAD Signs in advance of the intersection. Below the STOP Signs, we will install ALL-WAY Plaques to indicate that all approaches are required to stop. These signs will also be installed below the existing stop signs on Strickersville Road.
