Dear Garth -

I trust all is well.

As you are aware, Legislative Reapportionment is a topic of significant interest. In my view, a wholesale change in the process of drawing legislative districts is one of the most important and lasting reforms we could undertake as a General Assembly.

While there are many views on how such reform could be accomplished, I believe a Citizens Commission approach, which removes political officials and elected legislators from the process, is the best path forward. Removing elected officials from the process of drawing legislative districts removes a clear conflict of interest, and I believe it would go a long way to increasing the public's confidence both specifically in reapportionment, and in broadly in state government as a whole.

I appreciate the thoughtful review that the State Government Committee has given to this topic during this legislative session, and I am optimistic that reform-minded legislation will come to the House floor for a vote. I am strongly supportive of moving forward with a Citizens Commission approach for legislative reapportionment.
